Internal Revenue Service, Criminal Investigation is the federal law enforcement agency responsible for investigating potential criminal violations of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code and related financial crimes in a manner intended to foster confidence in the tax system and deter violations of tax law.

If the motive of the crime is money, chances are Criminal Investigations (CI) special agents are involved in tracking the money from the crime to the criminal. Today's sophisticated schemes to defraud the government and the American economy demand the financial analytical ability of forensic investigators to wade through complex paper and computerized financial records.
